
KFPS. Meeting Thursday 16th July Guest Speaker:

Tanya Pritchard Queensland Trust For Nature.


Tanya will talk on Koala surveys in our area as well as possible research issues in Karawatha Forest. The Trust purchased Koala Crossing at Peak Crossing south of Ipswich last year. Peak Crossing is part of the Flinders Karawatha Corridor - the largest remaining continuous stretch of open eucalypt forest in South East Queensland – and was at risk of being cleared. "Reptiles, Frogs and Bats using the Compton Rd. Land Bridge".

Last month we had a fascinating talk from Melanie McGregor on the Reptiles, Frogs & Bats using the Compton Road Land Bridge. Her research points to a higher diversity of species on the actual bridge than in the forest on either side. Sadly in the last few months **she has found increasing evidence of two of our worst feral predators being cats and foxes**. Both have been caught on cameras and we will have to move quickly to curb the population before it impacts further on our smaller wildlife. Anything from the size of a bandicoot down can fall prey to these predators. Melanie will be presenting her research in Sweden later in the year as this land bridge model had been duplicated there as well as a few other countries, we look forward to an update after she returns. The graph below shows that the number of animals ON the overpass is greater than the numbers on each side on the land.
